



Examples of Professional Salon Products containing Prop. 65 Carcinogens and Reproductive Toxicants reported to the CA Safe Cosmetics Program

Regis Designline Moisturizing Shampoo contains three carcinogens (arsenic, cocamide diethanolamine (DEA), Formaldehyde (gas)); one possible carcinogen (1,4-Dioxane); three developmental toxin and carcinogens (acrylamide, lead, ethylene oxide); a carcinogen and male reproductive toxin (dichloroacetic acid); and a respiratory irritant (ethylene glycol).



<u>Great Clips Tea Tree Shampoo</u> is registered in the database with a "<u>trade secret</u>" which means the product is formulated with a Prop. 65 toxic chemical that the public would not know is there, if not for its disclosure to the Safe Cosmetics Database.



Regis Design Line Texture Cream Casual Styler contains known or probable human carcinogens <u>Formaldehyde</u> (gas), <u>acetaldehyde</u>, <u>1,4-Dioxane</u>, N-Nitrosodimethylamine, propylene oxide and <u>benzene</u> as well as <u>benzyl chloride</u>, a respiratory tract irritant; <u>ethylene oxide</u>, a developmental toxin .



John Paul Mitchell <u>Modern Elixirs Styling Serum</u> contains <u>styrene</u>. Styrene can be absorbed through the skin or inadvertently ingested and is considered a possible human carcinogen by the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC).



Vibrant Sexy Hair Sulfate Free <u>Color Lock Shampoo</u> is registered in the database because it contains <u>ethyl acrylate</u>, a known carcinogen.



Kenra Professional <u>Curl Defining Crème</u> is registered in the database as containing methyleugenol which is a Prop. 65 carcinogen.

OPI Nail Envy is registered in the database because it contains Formaldehyde, a known carcinogen and irritant, and titanium dioxide, a possible carcinogen.



Regis Designline Interrupt Texturing Clay was first reported to the database in 2009 listing "trade secret" and six reportable Prop. 65 ingredients: including acetaldehyde, 1,4-Dioxane, ethylene oxide, Formaldehyde, Methyl chloride, and silica. The product was updated in 2014 to include arsenic and titanium dioxide.



John Paul Mitchell Heat Seal Styling Spray is registered in the database as containing styrene.



Great Clips Men's Daily Shampoo is registered in the database because it contains cocamide diethanolamine which is a carcinogen.



Regis Designline Intensity Conditioning Therapy is registered in the database as containing four known or possible carcinogens and three reproductive toxins: 1,4-Dioxane, ethylene oxide, Formaldehyde, Methyl chloride, acetaldehyde, arsenic, and Vitamin A Palmitate.



Seshe Rose nail polish is registered in the database because it contains titanium dioxide, a possible carcinogen, and toluene, a reproductive toxin.
